Christ Presbyterian Church is a new church plant in Reading initiated by the Susquehanna Valley Presbytery of the Presbyterian Church in America (www.PCAnet.org). The church is dedicated to Christ-centered worship and ministry, regular exposition of the Bible, and creating a welcoming environment for believers and the unconvinced. Particularly, in a time when the church is often identified with the culture wars of the left and the right, Christ Presbyterian emphasizes a Christ-centered focus of ministry. We are a church desiring to minister to the city and the surrounding region in hopes that, according to the promise of Jesus Christ, a unified congregation of all nations and backgrounds would be formed that would help establish the body of Christ in Berks County.

Founding Pastor Mel Sensenig grew up in Wernersville, and spent the last 11 years in New England, where he earned his Master of Divinity at Yale University and then planted Trinity Presbyterian Church in Providence, Rhode Island. He and his family live in Shillington where a community Bible study has been meeting in his home over the summer.

Sunday evening meetings will begin on September 11 at 6 p.m. at the Wyndham Hotel, 104th Street, Reading. September 11, 18 and 25 will be informational meetings. Following September, Sunday evenings will consist of singing, Bible study and prayer also at 6 PM at the Wyndham. Parking, pre-K childcare, coffee and dessert are provided. All are welcome and invited to attend regardless of religious persuasion. Wednesday evening community group meetings will continue on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday evenings of each month throughout the fall and are open to all as well.
